Ash Wednesday ushers in the season of Lent and Suffering before Easter

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent and Suffering before Easter. It is a time of fasting, self-examination, when we can focus our thoughts on Christ's suffering and sacrifice for our sake. Ash Wednesday (the Wednesday before the sixth Sunday before Easter) begins a special time in the Church year, in which we are called to follow Christ on his final journey to Jerusalem, on the path of suffering, on the way of the cross. The motivation and meaning of Lent is that we are able to see Christ's suffering as the key to our suffering, Christ's sacrifice as God's answer to the guilt of our sin.

Juris Zariņš, pastor of St. John's Parish in Riga, writes: "Since the time of the early church, this time of remembrance has been considered a time of seriousness, self-denial and fasting, with a particular emphasis on the awareness of sin and repentance. The period from Ash Wednesday to Easter, excluding Sundays, is exactly 40 days of Lent and serves as a comparison with Christ's 40-day fast in the desert. This period is a time when Christians abstain from pleasures, observe fasting and attend all church services. It is a time of love and devotion, when they sacrifice worldly goods in order to gain spiritual ones".

Let us follow Christ's call at this time, which we read in the Gospel of Matthew: "And when you fast, do not look gloomy like the hypocrites; for they disfigure their faces that they may appear to men to be fasting. Truly I say to you, they have their reward. But when you fast, anoint your head and wash your face, so that you may not appear to men to be fasting, but to your Father who sees in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you" (Matthew 6:16-18).

However, 15 members came to the general meeting and four more apologized.

Each of our three Latvian organizations must elect two directors of the Center's board. When we needed a second director, Indulis Bernšteins applied to serve on the board. For that, we thank Indulis.

The treasurer had worked a lot on the draft budget for next year, and the treasurer then presented it to

So again we elected Ilmārs Rudaks as the long-time head of the branch and the previous committee, so that he can continue to work again, for which they, thank you.

The main goal of our branch has been and remains to provide as much help as possible to our legionnaires in Latvia, to support large families and the Occupation Museum there. But we can only do this for as much as our finances allow us.

As we have become accustomed to, after the general meeting, we enjoyed snacks prepared by our Vanadzes, tea or coffee and also a glass of wine. Thank you to the giver for that. Then we say goodbye and hope to meet at our next event: the commemoration of Oskars Kalpaks, the Courland Fortress and the Latvian Legion, already on March 9th.
